

Job Advertisement: Green Team Lawn Care (3 positions)



The Elmwood Community Resource Centre is seeking 3 Green Team Members to begin on June 4 for 30 hours a week until August 31, 2018. Rate of pay is \$11.15 an hour.

Green Team members will perform light yard-work and lawn-care in the Elmwood area. This will include mowing grass, weed-whacking, watering plants, raking grass/leaves, removing litter, painting and cleaning up graffiti. Other duties can include assisting at community events and helping out at our youth drop-in programming. The Green Team members also perform administrative duties such as log books, waiver forms, incident reports, monthly reports and other documentation.

The Green Team Lawn Care will:

- Remove graffiti and debris from residential, businesses, bus shacks and public sidewalks
- Provide yard maintenance for residences and agencies of Elmwood and Chalmers area
- Maintain & organize daily paperwork; including daily log books, statistics and waiver forms for local residences and businesses
- Work with Elmwood East Kildonan Active Living Centre (180 Poplar) for yard maintenance; as well as other organizations in the area as required
- Assist with local events; including community clean up drives, festivals and block parties
- Maintain raised flower/vegetable gardens
- Set up and clean-up of program activities
- Ensure an environment of acceptance is maintained no bullying, racist/sexist remarks; being aware of events and participants involved
- Engage and participate with children/youth in activities such as sports, recreation, cooking, volunteer work, cultural specific crafts.
- Provide supervision of children and youth

Qualifications:

- Must be between 16-29 years old
- Have a desire to work on entry- level neighbourhood renewal activities
- Criminal Record Check, Child Abuse Registry Check, or willingness to obtain them during probation period required for applicants 18 years of age or older
- Computer skills; Word and Windows experience would be an asset
- Strong verbal and written communication skills
- Interest in helping others, working individually as well as cooperatively with others
- Able to work individually as well as part of a team
- Familiarity with Elmwood community is an asset

Working Conditions:

- Daytime hours Monday-Fridays
- Some non- standard hours of work-evenings and weekends for special events
- Criminal record and Child Abuse check required
- Working outdoors in the Elmwood/Chalmers area
